When the cremains were marched thru the columns of veterans at attention, the wind softly blew as if the spirits of these men were rejoicing in reaching the end of their mission. Honors were bestowed by four branches of the military, as about 150 people united by the need to witness these men being set in their rightful resting place, proudly looked on.
