**After Action Report  
Tahoma National Cemetery  
March 30, 2018**

**On March 30, 2018 the remains of 5 US Army veterans, 3 spouses and dependents, recovered from Skagit County Coroner's Office and other locations were transported from Bellingham, Washington to Tahoma National Cemetery in Kent, Washington for interment. The transport vehicle was escorted by 3 riders and a support vehicle comprised of Goldwing Road Riders and Patriot Guard Riders, a distance of approximately 120 miles to a rally point in Maple Valley, Washington where it was joined by an additional 17 Patriot Guard riders, three family members, and MIAP volunteers who completed the escort to TNC.**

Interment ceremony, with full military honors, was conducted by the Assistant State Coordinator for Washington, supported by a US Army active duty honor guard from JBLM and PGR flag line. Additional support was received from a volunteer Chaplain and rifle team from The American Legion. A flag was presented to a family member of one of the recovered veterans. The interment was complete approximately 1430 hrs.
