The MIAP will lead a veteran's service organization & military escort for our heroes from Blake-Lamb Funeral Home in Oak Lawn to Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery (ALNC) in Elwood IL. A flag line will be held by the Patriot Guard Riders and other veteran's organizations to facilitate a dignified transfer of our heroes to their final resting place. MIAP Chaplain Ed Hedlin of St. Anne will officiate the service.
