WILLIAMSBURG, Virginia – The MISSING IN AMERICA PROJECT, in the Commonwealth of Virginia will conduct a ceremony and honor seventy-five (75) cremated remains who were left at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, DC.

In cooperation with the National Park Service the service will be conducted, with full military honors, at 11:00 am, Saturday, November 17, 2018 at Woodbine Cemetery, Manassas, Virginia.

The purpose of the MISSING IN AMERICA PROJECT is to locate, identify and inter the unclaimed cremated remains of veterans through the joint efforts of private, state and federal organizations; to provide honor and respect to those who have served this country, by securing a final resting place for these forgotten Heroes.
