**After Action Report
MIAP Experience Bus Tour
Quantico National Cemetery, Virginia
26 April 2019**

On this date, at 1430hrs, a bus from AAA East Central Pittsburg, PA, arrived at Quantico National Cemetery for a tour of the cemetery and presentations on the Missing In America Project. There were 38 adults and one driver in attendance.

Presentations about Quantico National Cemetery and MIAP were provided by Tracy Ashley, Quantico National Cemetery staff, and I, as we toured the cemetery grounds.

Upon arriving at Section 22 of the cemetery, everyone disembarked the bus and posted American flags (provided by the Prince William County Office of Tourism) at veteran grave sites. Since there were numerous flags already posted, we did not restrict the posting to only MIAP veterans and spouses.

After re-boarding the tour bus, we traveled to Section 17, where relatives of SSgt John William Yeager, USAF, disembarked the bus and posted a wreath at his grave (Site 730) while attendees sang "God Bless America". We then re-boarded the bus and presentations continued and questions were answered.
