On April 27th 2019 at the Arizona Veterans' Memorial Cemetery at Marana, Arizona, 17 **almost forgotten Veterans** were laid to rest with honors.

Patriots gathered from all over Arizona. A hearse provided by American Heritage Hearse Service (AHHS) carrying the 17 sets of Cremains was escorted by 100 motorcycles, on which many 3'x5' U.S. flags were proudly flown. The escort also included close to 15 vehicles filled with additional patriots. The Procession started at Adair Avalon Chapel and went directly to Arizona Veteran's Memorial Cemetery at Marana. When the cremains were marched thru the columns of veterans at attention, the wind briskly blew as if the spirits of these men were rejoicing in reaching the end of their mission. Honors were bestowed by four branches of the military, as about 200 people united by the need to witness these men being set in their rightful resting place, proudly looked on.

To respectfully accomplish this mission, MIAP was supported by several Veteran Service Organizations, Veteran Motorcycle Groups and Law Enforcement Agencies from Pima County, and local Law enforcement from Oro Valley and Marana.
