**After Action Report
MIAP Experience Bus Tour
Quantico National Cemetery, Virginia
17 May 2019**

On this date, at 2:45pm, the Texas Permian Basin Honor Flight, arrived at Quantico National Cemetery, for a tour of the cemetery and presentations about the Missing In America Project. There were 100 veterans from WWII, Korean, Vietnam and the Middle East. A Gold Star family, Honor Flight Guardians, tour guides and bus drivers were in attendance.

The group was provided presentations about Quantico National Cemetery and MIAP, by Tracey Ashley (Quantico National Cemetery), John Tutunjian (Member of MIAP's Board of Directors and Virginia Assistant State Coordinator), Marie Vayer (DAR), and I while we toured the cemetery grounds.

Upon arriving at Section 22 of the cemetery, everyone (to include a few veterans in wheelchairs) disembarked the bus. Brief presentations were made by James Sanders, Director, Quantico National Cemetery, and I. Upon completion of the presentations, the Honor Flight representatives posted a wreath at the stone designating Section 22 – thus recognizing everyone with Section 22. A Marine Honor Guard then rendered a 3 round rifle volley, and taps. After taps, everyone posted American flags (provided by the Prince William County Office of Tourism) at MIAP grave sites.

After re-boarding the tour bus, presentations continued and questions were answered.
