## **After Action Report MIAP Mission, Quantico National Cemetery 11 July 2019**

On 11 July 2019, at 1100hrs, the Missing In American Project laid to rest at Quantico National Cemetery the previously unclaimed cremains of two veterans.

The Prince William County Sheriff's Office provided the cremains of a retired Navy LCDR that passed away on 1 May 2019. The Spotsylvania County Sheriff's Office provided the cremains of a US Army PFC that passed away in 2017.

50+ people were in attendance, to include representatives of the Prince William Sheriff's Office, the Spotsylvania County Sheriff's Office, the Daughters of the American Revolution, the US Navy Honor Guard, the US Army Honor Guard, American Legion Post 290 Rifle Team, Ben Corner (Bugles Across America), representatives of the American Red Cross, riders from American Legion Post 10 and 176, two former neighbors of the Navy LCDR, and others.

Assisting with the distribution of service programs (see attached) and cold water was Mr. Cameron Ryan, a member of the Woodbridge Senior High School Jr. ROTC.

Also noteworthy was Caleb Green, MSG, US Army, retired, from the Center for American Military Music Opportunities (CAMMO), who sang the National Anthem and Amazing Grace (grave side).

The flag honoring LCDR Eckard was presented to a former neighbor. The flag honoring PFC Childs was presented to Detective Short, Spotsylvania County Sheriff's Office. Det. Short will have the flag encased in a shadow box and placed, along with a plaque, in their showcase.
