## After Action Report Oregon Trail State Veterans Cemetery, Evansville, WY 24 JUL 2020

On this day the cremains of 16 veterans and two spouses were honorably transferred from Champion Funeral Home in Sheridan to Oregon Trail Veteran's Cemetery in Evansville.

Due to Covid -19 restrictions there was no escort.

Upon arrival at the cemetery the cremains and flags were carried into the chapel by urn bearers from the Patriot Guard Riders. The wooden urns were crafted with help from the Sheridan Home Depot, Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1560, A.S. MacKenzie Chapter NSUSD 1812, and Kane Funeral home.

The memorial was led by Cecil Barnes, longtime head of the Natrona County United Veterans Council. The ceremony was brief due to Covid-19 restrictions and few people were in attendance.

The weather was beautiful, and the mission was successful, ensuring support for Missing in America Project across the state of Wyoming.
