A presentation on the Mission of the Missing in America Project (MIAP) was made by Daniel Poirier, Missouri State Coordinator, to the Volunteer Service Council in St. Louis, Missouri.

Approximately 20 members were in attendance. The 65-minute PowerPoint presentation provided an overview of the Missing in America Project and its mission to locate, identify, and inter the unclaimed cremated remains of American veterans.

The presentation also discussed the importance of honoring veterans who, for various reasons, were left without family or others to ensure their final disposition. Information was provided on the role of MIAP volunteers and how members of the community can become involved in helping fulfill the organization's mission.

The presentation concluded with an opportunity for questions and discussion regarding MIAP's work and volunteer opportunities.
