## After Action Report WA State MIAP 3/28/2025

On March 20, 2025, WA MIAP recovered four cremains from a Seattle Funeral Home.

Civil War Veteran 1LT David J. McKinney (1844-1923) was delivered to the Calvary Cemetery in Seattle. On 3/27/2025 he was placed in one of the plots he owned next to his wife, Katharine (1848-1907). 1LT McKinney had received military honors at an earlier ceremony for Civil War Veterans.

Civil War Veteran 1LT Jasper N. Bertram (1838-1928) was mailed to Richfield, KS, to be placed with his wife, Mary (1848-1888). He had also received military honors before the mailing of his cremains.

Harriet "Hattie" Van Deusen (1838-1914) was mailed to St. Joseph, MI, to be placed with her Civil War Veteran spouse PVT Peter Van Deusen (1835-1914).

Five day old Mae Wagley, (Feb-Mar 1923), was mailed to St. Charles, IL, to be placed with her father, James (1903-1934). He served from 1921-1924.

All cremains have reached their final destination.
