2 Idaho Unclaimed Veterans and 1 Veteran Dependent to Receive Military Funeral Honors

Twin Falls, Idaho (March 3, 2022) – The MISSING IN AMERICA PROJECT will conduct its first mission in Twin Falls, Idaho by honoring two veterans whose remains have been in the care of the Twin Falls Coroner's office yet remained unclaimed. We will also honor one of the veteran's dependent wife.

Services will be conducted with full military honors for the following veterans at 1:00 p.m., Friday, April 8th, at the Snake River Canyon National Cemetery, 1585 E Elm St, in Buhl, ID.
