The purpose of the Missing in America Project (MIAP) is to locate, identify and inter the unclaimed cremated remains of American veterans through the joint efforts of private, state and federal organizations, and to provide honor, respect and dignity to those who have served this country by securing a final resting place for these forgotten heroes.

“It’s The Right Thing To Do”

Tuesday, April 12, 2022, MIAP Alabama with the cooperation of a Dignity Memorial will inter the unclaimed remains of one eligible spouse who died in 1959. The spouse’s Veteran was honorably discharged after serving as an Army First Lieutenant flying aerial photography missions during World War I. The Veteran died in 1949. The deceased wife was born in 1896 and she died while visiting family in 1959.

This service is open to the public. Photos and a report will be posted on the Support Committee for the Alabama National Cemetery (<https://scalnc.org/>) the day after the service. Local TV/Print media is welcome.

Participants will assemble in the assembly lane in front of the administrative building at the Alabama National Cemetery no later than 10:00 am. At 10:15 am, the cortege will depart for the committal shelter with a motorcycle escort. The service will include a singer, opening prayer by clergy, remarks by Alabama DAR Representative, bell ringing, closing music, transport to the columbarium, placement in the niche and closing prayer.
