MISSION STATEMENT

The purpose of the Missing in America Project (MIAP) is to locate, identify and inter the unclaimed cremated remains of American veterans through the joint efforts of private, state and federal organizations, and to provide honor, respect and dignity to those who have served this country by securing a final resting place for these forgotten heroes.

“IT’S THE RIGHT THING TO DO”

On Thursday, April 22, 2021 at 2:00pm, MIAP – Florida, in cooperation with Volusia Memorial Crematory and Funeral Home and Baldwin Brothers Funeral and Cremation Services, MIAP will be interring the unclaimed cremains of 17 veterans, and 2 spouses of veterans, with full military honors, at the Cape Canaveral National Cemetery located at 5525 US Hwy. 1, Mims, FL 32754.

The veterans being interred served in the US Army, Marine Corp, Navy and Air Force during World War II, Korea, Vietnam and other non-war specific periods.

The longest that any of these being interred has been unclaimed is since 1978.

There will be an escort for this service that will leave from American Legion Post 1, 1281 N. US Hwy. 1, Titusville, FL 32796, to the cemetery. All motorcycle organizations, riders, and vehicles are welcome to participate. Further details for meeting time and KSU will be forth coming.

There will be a short rehearsal before the service at 1:00pm at the CCNC.

At this time, due to coronavirus issues and the National Cemetery Administration’s policies regarding the number of individuals that can attend services at national cemeteries, this service will not be publicized or open to the public. Individuals that are invited to participate in the service must wear face masks and maintain social distancing. Should these policies change before the date of the service, an updated announcement will be issued.
