MISSION STATEMENT

The purpose of the Missing in America Project (MIAP) is to locate, identify and inter the unclaimed cremated remains of American veterans through the joint efforts of private, state, and federal organizations, and to provide honor, respect, and dignity to those who have served this country by securing a final resting place for these forgotten heroes.

"IT'S THE RIGHT THING TO DO"

On Thursday, May 5, 2022, at 10:00am, MIAP – Florida, in cooperation with the Dignity Memorial's Kraeer Funeral Home at Forest Lawn Memorial Gardens in Pompano Beach and the Kraeer Funeral Home and Cremation Centers in Broward and Palm Beach Counties, and the Miami-Dade County Medical Examiner Department Indigent Cremation Services, will be interring the unclaimed cremains of 17 veterans, and 7 spouses of veterans, with full military honors, at the South Florida National Cemetery.

The veterans being interred served in the US Army, Navy, and Air Force, during World Wars I and II, Korea, Vietnam, and other non-war specific periods. The longest that any of these that we will be interring has been unclaimed is since 1955.

This service is still in the planning stage. Additional details will be released when finalized.
