The purpose of the Missing in America Project (MIAP) is to locate, identify and inter the unclaimed cremated remains of American veterans through the joint efforts of private, state and federal organizations, and to provide honor, respect and dignity to those who have served this country by securing a final resting place for these forgotten heroes.

“It’s The Right Thing To Do”

Thursday, May 15, 2025, MIAP Alabama with the cooperation of a Dignity Memorial will inter the unclaimed cremains of one eligible Veteran who died in 2006. The Veteran was honorably retired from the military after serving as a US Army soldier and a Master Sergeant in the Air Force. He served during the WW II and Korean War periods. Our Veteran died in 2006 at the age of 89.

This service is open to the public. Photos and a report will be posted on the Support Committee for the Alabama National Cemetery website (<https://scalnc.org/>) and MIAP Alabama Facebook page within two days of the event. Local TV/Print media is welcome.

Participants will assemble in the assembly lane in front of the administrative building at the Alabama National Cemetery no later than 10:00 am. At 10:15 am, the cortege will depart for the committal shelter with a motorcycle escort. The service will include flyby, military honors, live TAPS, flag folding, prayer, singer, bell ringing, remarks, closing prayer, flag-line, transport to the columbarium and placement in the niche.
