The purpose of the Missing In America Project (MIAP) is to locate, identify and inter the unclaimed cremated remains of American veterans through the joint efforts of private, state and federal organizations. To provide honor and respect to those who have served this country by securing a final resting place for these forgotten heroes.

On Wednesday May 31, 2023 at 1:15 PM, a joint mission between the Oregon and Washington MIAP chapters, in cooperation with our partners at Dignity Memorial’s Lincoln Memorial Park & Funeral Home, Evergreen Memorial Gardens, and Willamette National Cemetery will hold a graveside service with full military honors for 6 unclaimed Veterans, with acknowledgement of 7 unclaimed dependents at Willamette National Cemetery.

The veterans were located and identified by Oregon and Washington MIAP volunteers. The veterans being honored served in the USAF, US Army, and US Navy. The dependents include 3 infants, including one who has been unclaimed since 1915.

All are invited to attend the ceremony to honor our American Heroes. No one should be alone on that final day. Please join us as we stand as their family. A catered reception will be held following the service at Lincoln Memorial Park & Funeral Home courtesy of Dignity Memorial.

Please arrive by 1:00 PM at either Willamette National Cemetery as directed by WNC staff or at Lincoln Memorial Park & Funeral Home (11801 SE Mt. Scott Blvd.) to join a procession to the committal shelter.
