Tuesday June 8, 2021, MIAP – Alabama with the cooperation of a local Funeral Home will inter the unclaimed cremains of one US Navy Veteran who served honorably during the Vietnam War period.

This service is open to the public and all are welcome to attend. Photos and a report will be posted on the Support Committee for the Alabama National Cemetery site (<https://scalnc.org/>) the day after the service. Media are also welcome.

Participants will assemble in the assembly lane in front of the administrative building at the Alabama National Cemetery no later than 10:00 am. At 10:15 the cortege will depart for the committal shelter. The service will include a PGR/ALR Flag line, welcome, prayer, music, brief remarks by a Vietnam veteran, bell ringing, live TAPS, flag folding, benediction and closing song.
