MISSION STATEMENT

The purpose of the Missing in America Project (MIAP) is to locate, identify and inter the unclaimed cremated remains of American veterans through the joint efforts of private, state and federal organizations, and to provide honor, respect and dignity to those who have served this country by securing a final resting place for these forgotten heroes.

"IT'S THE RIGHT THING TO DO"

On Wednesday, September 29, 2021, at 10:00am, MIAP – Florida, in cooperation with the Kraeer Funeral Home at Forest Lawn Memorial Gardens in Pompano Beach and the Kraeer Funeral Home and Cremation Centers in Broward and Palm Beach Counties, and the Miami-Dade County Medical Examiner Department Indigent Cremation Services, will be interring the unclaimed cremains of 17 veterans and 7 spouses of veterans, with full military honors, at the South Florida National Cemetery.

The veterans to be interred served in the US Army, Marine Corps., Navy and Army Air Force during World Wars I and II, Korea, and Vietnam. The longest that any of these to be interred has been unclaimed is since 1964.

This service is still in the planning stage, and, due to continuing Covid 19 issues which could affect the National Cemetery Administration's policy regarding the number of individuals that can attend services at national cemeteries, additional details regarding this service will be announced when finalized.
