MISSION STATEMENT

The purpose of the Missing in America Project (MIAP) is to locate, identify and inter the unclaimed cremated remains of American veterans through the joint efforts of private, state, and federal organizations, and to provide honor, respect, and dignity to those who have served this country by securing a final resting place for these forgotten heroes.

“IT’S THE RIGHT THING TO DO”

On Thursday, October 27, 2022, at 10:00am, MIAP – Florida, in cooperation with the Dignity Memorial’s Kraeer Funeral Home at Forest Lawn Memorial Gardens North in Pompano Beach, and the Miami-Dade County Medical Examiner Department Indigent Cremation Services, will be interring the unclaimed cremains of 18 veterans, and 6 spouses of veterans, with full military honors, at the South Florida National Cemetery.

The veterans being interred served in the US Army, Navy, Army Air Forces and Coast Guard, during World Wars I and II, Korea, Vietnam, and non-war specific periods. The longest that any of these that we will be interring has been unclaimed is since 1959.

This service is open to all residents of our area communities.

There will be an escort of the Hearse led by the Palm Beach Sheriff’s Office that will leave from the Southeast parking area (the Lantana Road side) of the Wellington South Super Target Store at 5900 Florida State Road 7 (Rt. 441), on the Northeast corner of State Road 7 and Lantana Road. All motorcycle organizations, riders, and vehicles are welcome to participate. Meeting time is 8:45am for a safety briefing, and the escort will depart (KSU) to the cemetery at 9:15am.
