**MISSION STATEMENT**

The purpose of the Missing in America Project (MIAP) is to locate, identify and inter the unclaimed cremated remains of American veterans through the joint efforts of private, state, and federal organizations. To provide honor, respect, and dignity to those who have served this country by securing a final resting place for these forgotten heroes.

**“IT’S THE RIGHT THING TO DO”**

On Monday, November 14, 2022, at 1:00pm, MIAP - Washington, in cooperation with the Dignity Memorial’s Butterworth Funeral Home and Evergreen Washelli Funeral Home will be honoring 98 veterans, 14 spouses and 10 dependent children. Most will then be transferred to Washington State Veterans Cemetery on November 16<sup>th</sup> for final placement. Eight veterans will be interred at Tahoma National Cemetery and three veterans will be scheduled for burial at sea at a future date.

The veterans being interred served in the US Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Army Air Forces, Coast Guard and Merchant Marine during the Spanish American War, World Wars I and II, Korea, Vietnam, and non-war specific periods. The longest that any of these has been unclaimed is 110 years, since 1912.

This service is open to all residents of our area communities.
